Clew Bay Marine Services is based at Inishturkbeg Boatyard, on Inishturkbeg - an island located near Kilmeena, between Newport and Westport, Co. Mayo. The Boatyard is a unique facility in Clew Bay, designed to serve the needs of commercial and leisure boats in the immediate area of Clew Bay and Co. Mayo in general. We can be reached on all tides. With a 50-metre concrete slipway, and 8 tonne trolley, leading to the Boathouse, virtually all power boats up to about 12 metres or 40 ft in length can be accommodated. The Boathouse is fully equipped with lifting winches and all necessary equipment to conduct major and minor services for marine craft.

Services provided by our expert, experienced team:

- Routine hull, mechanical and electrical maintenance
- Preparation of leisure boats for seasonal use, including winterising
- Painting and Anti-fouling
- Production and application of decals
- Routine and Emergency repairs for hulls, chines and keels, including fibreglassing and keel-band fitting
- Stainless steel and aluminium fabrications and repairs
- Electronic aids installation, upgrades and servicing
- Maintenance and repair of inflatables
- Department of Transport-compliant inspection facilities for licensing surveys
- Pick-up and Drop-off available for water-based vessels

All of these marine services are facilitated by our fleet:

Multi-Mac – licensed, aluminium-built, and carrying her own crane she is suitable for all sorts of installation and maintenance work, whilst safely carrying goods, provisions and workmen

Clew Less – a licensed, light and versatile powered raft, useful for work such as maintenance of nets and shore clearance

Clew Mor – licensed to carry 12 passengers with large cabin and on-board w/c - she is also ideal for the carriage of State and County officers who need safe, comfortable and fast access to the increasingly focused-upon environs of Clew Bay.

Islander – ideal for access to difficult navigational areas, her characteristics allow for safe working on perches and buoys. This vessel is also licensed by the Department of the Marine for 6 passengers.

Sea Rover - a licensed (up to 5 passengers) 6.8metre Tornado Rib ideal for the rapid transport of personnel for inspection of sites, especially in harsher weather. She is also ideal for photography whilst holding station in all sea states

CataTurk – comfortable 7m Cheetah Marine cabin catamaran, for bay sight-seeing, with great weather protection and beach access, available for bare-boat charter (with suitably qualified operator)

Ocean Potion – fast, stable, luxury 11 metre (36ft) Cheetah Marine catamaran, featured at the London Boat Show, with all conveniences, available for bare-boat charter (with suitably qualified operator)
